



Social Determinants of Health Screening Tools

The Social Determinants of Health (SDoH): Social Needs Screening & Referral incentive measure requires that specific tools be used to screen for food, housing, and transportation.

To assist clinical partners in selecting from the many available screening tools approved by OHA, Umpqua Health has identified two commonly used tools approved by the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA) and the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS). These tools include questions covering all three required domains: food, housing, and transportation.

Umpqua Health will collect social needs data from providers and partner organizations to enhance member services and referrals. The methods for capturing social needs screening and referral information include a Community Information Exchange (CIE), claims data, or electronic health records (EHR) or a combination of these sources.

Patients who decline screening or referral in all three domains using an OHA-approved or exempted screening tool are excluded from the metric. Providers may consider using the Z53.29 code to indicate a screening or referral decline. Additional guidance from OHA may be necessary.
