buprenorphine/naloxone SL tablets	Removed PA requirements. Still must follow
	Suboxone/buprenorphine policy.
levalbuterol HFA inhaler	Removed PA requirements.
polyethylene glycol 3350 powder packets	Removed from formulary.
QVAR Redihaler	Added to formulary without PA
	Requirements.
amlodipine/valsartan/HCTZ	Added PA requirements.
Oral Contraceptives	Removed step therapy requirements from
	formulary. However, some formulations
	now require PA instead, please see print
	formulary for further information on
	specific drugs.
