### *UHA to Help Fund Community Projects*

**ROSEBURG, Ore.**, October 1, 2019 – Umpqua Health Alliance’s Community Advisory Council is now accepting applications for community projects.

The Community Advisory Council, or CAC, has earmarked more than a quarter of a million dollars for projects that help improve the overall health of Douglas County residents. The funding stream aims to address the key focus areas addressed in the most recent Community Health Improvement Plan: behavioral health innovations, social determinants of health, families, children and healthy lifestyles, and inviting programs which improve health equity.

Since 2016, Umpqua Health Alliance has designated more than \$1,000,000 for these community health improvement programs.
