### ABOUT UMPQUA HEALTH TRANSITIONAL CARE

Umpqua Health and ATRIO are working together to offer their members the opportunity to participate in a program they sponsor called Transitional Care Interventions (TCI). The program helps bridge the gap between hospital, home, and follow-up care with your primary care provider. Additionally, the TCI team offers health coaching to assist you in gaining confidence in managing your medical needs. The coaching program includes one face to face visit and follow-up phone calls for two to three weeks after hospital discharge. The goal is to help you make the transition from the hospital back to your home and guide further medical follow-up.
