The Intensive Care Coordinators (ICC) connect you with local services. These services help you with non-medical needs that affect your health. They can help you with:

- Home health
- Care Coordination
- Rides to your doctor
- Substance abuse treatment
- Help with food, housing, or money
- Physical Health
- Mental Health
- Counseling support

ICC's can help with communicate with your doctors, caseworkers, and other people involved in your healthcare. Your ICC can answer questions and help you know the benefits and limits of your UHA CCO health plan.
