Community groups encouraged to apply for funding

ROSEBURG – Umpqua Health Alliance’s Community Advisory Council is now accepting applications for community projects in 2023.

The Community Advisory Council (CAC) has allocated \$300,000 in recent years for projects that help improve the overall health of Douglas County residents. The funding stream aims to enhance the key focus areas addressed in the most recent Community Health Improvement Plan: behavioral health innovations, social determinants of health, families, children and healthy lifestyles, and inviting programs which improve health equity.

Since 2016, Umpqua Health Alliance has designated nearing \$2 million for these community health improvement programs.
