A. OHA Update	<p>Bevin shared information on an error on the letters sent. Originally it was thought that 19k were impacted, but actually 11k were sent out (mostly to folks who had never sent out a notice). Sent a follow up letter to all of these folks. 7 out of 10 Oregonians will keep their OHP (losing folks with higher incomes), but the Bridge Program will help with this population. A website is coming (timeline TBD, but likely November). Question: is there any county-specific data? Bevin: there's a dashboard! Available for public viewing at: https://www.oregon.gov/odhs/agency/pages/oep-one-dashboards.aspx#redeterminations</p> <p>But this is also only as good as the information given to OHA. There's also a place to see the wait time for the call center.</p> <p>Asking any interested participants to join a work group to study recruitment and retention of BH providers. Looking for people with lived experience and people from communities that have historical inequities.
