## Quality Incentive Program



Getting the right care at the right time helps you stay healthy. Umpqua Health Alliance works with your providers to support care that improves your health, including preventive visits and screenings.

One way we do this is by recognizing providers who meet care goals that improve your health. This is done through what are called **quality incentive payments**, or extra payments for meeting care goals.

### What Are Quality Incentive Payments?

Quality incentive payments are extra payments providers can earn when they meet care goals.

Key health services includes:

- Preventive care visits
- Childhood immunizations
- Care for long-term health conditions
- Behavioral health care
- Health screenings

Stay up to date on checkups, screenings and recommended care. Talk to your provider about what care is right for you.

Each year, the Oregon Health Authority sets aside funding to reward health plans that improve health outcomes.

If Umpqua Health Alliance meets these goals, we receive funding and share it with providers who deliver better care for you.

Providers may earn quality incentive payments based on how well they meet state care goals and improve health outcomes.

Many types of providers can participate, including doctors, hospitals, behavioral health providers and dental providers.
